Lancaster Project List



Avenue L - 15th Street West to 40th Street West

Estimated investment: \$2,000,000

This project will update one of the City's busiest corridors to suit the evolving and growing needs of residents, including a signalized intersection at 32nd Street West. The project will utilize the Master Plan of Complete Streets to design roadway, pedestrian, and bikeway improvements that will provide multimodal access and safety.


Ave I - Sierra Hwy to 10th Street West

Estimated investment: \$623,846

The entire Avenue I corridor is of great importance to Lancaster. In fact, the City already has a capital improvement project scheduled for Avenue I from 10th Street West to 15th Street West. These two projects will complete the Complete Streets roadway improvements needed to finish the corridor.

Ave I - 15th Street West to 30th Street West

Estimated investment: \$1,363,763



These improvements will include: will include: narrowing sidewalks and filling sidewalk gaps to add landscaped planters and street trees; reducing the travel way down to two lanes in each direction; adding new raised landscaped medians that will shorten the crossing distances for pedestrians; treating the roadway surface; adding a buffered bike lane; replacing man hand crossing timers with countdown timers; adding new bus stop amenities; filling gaps in the sidewalk; and, addressing ADA Accessibility at curb ramps.

Sierra Hwy - Ave J to Ave L

Estimated investment: \$1,240,486

This historic roadway is a major arterial for Lancaster residents and regional travelers alike. However, as the City has grown and evolved, the neighborhoods that surround the corridor require a roadway that supports more pedestrian and bicycle access and safety. This project will redesign the roadway to be multimodal by reducing the lan widths, improving crossing connections for the bike path, as well as installing sidewalks where gaps exist to ensure continuity along corridor.

Challenger Way - Ave I to Ave L

Estimated investment: \$3,365,596

Challenger Way as it exists today was designed to provide the overland route of the space shuttle for which it is named. Whereas the shuttle program no longer requires this infrastructure, it is time to update this corridor to suit the needs of Lancaster residents. There are several schools and bustling business centers located in the Challenger Way neighborhoods which warrant that the roadway be redesigned with pedestrian and bicycle improvements throughout.
